One postpartum in-home visit and 1 Follow up call at 3 months. Central access point, intake and triage for p-1 month; referrals to county-wide Home Visiting, medical and social services. Central access point, intake, triage, and referrals to countywide HV and community resources for p-24 months. Embedded in FQHC perinatal. 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Family Spirit Northern Valley Indian Health (NVIH)	Pregnant individuals 28 weeks gestation and/ or those with children 0-3. Tribal verification or a parents tribal verification along with childs birth certificate. Residing in Yolo County and an established patient with Northern Valley Indian Health.	Up to age 3. All NVIH patients	English
Attachment and Biobehavioral Catch-up (ABC) First 5 Yolo, CWS, Yolo Crisis Nursery	Caregivers with children 0-4 who have been referred or authorized by CWS	10-12 sessions over 10-16 weeks	English Spanish
HMG In-home Therapy for Caregivers First 5 Yolo, CommuniCare+OLE Behavioral Health	Caregivers with 0-5 children and needing mental health support, not otherwise able to access care due to barriers like transportation or childcare	10-20 sessions	English, Spanish and Language Line for others
Parent Child+ Yolo First 5 Yolo, CalWORKs, Children's Therapy Center	Families with children 16 months-36 months at the time of first home visit; receiving CalWORKs or potentially eligible for CalWORKs	Up to 24 months; up to when the child is 48 months. Twice weekly 30 min home visits, 92 visits total.	English/Spanish and Hanna interpreting for other languages
Family Check-Up CWS, Yolo County Children's Alliance	Parents with children 2-17; Low-income, at risk of CWS involvment, SUD, IPV and other social factors that can increase child abuse/neglect.	Up to 6 months, flexible based on family unique needs	English/Spanish
Home Instruction for Parents of Preschool Youngsters Esparto Unified School District	Children 2-4 years old; Low-income, stay-at-home families	30 weeks of weekly home visits and 6 group sessions. September-May	English Spanish
California's Early Start Program Alta California Regional Center	<3 years of age, at least a 25% delay in one area of development	Until third birthday	Service Coordinators speak multiple languages. Interpreters are available for other languages
Warmline Family Resource Center Early Start support services & Family Empowerment Center	Early Start enrolled 0-3 families residing in Sacramento, Yolo, Alpine, Placer, El Dorado, or Nevada. Family Empowerment Center serves those with disabilities ages 3-22.	Community Navigator (trained peer parent) for 0-3. FEC offers referrals, training, and peer to peer support for 3-22	English/Spanish
